A properly working septic system keeps germs away from you!

Septic systems are “small wastewater treatment systems” in your backyard that treat all wastewater generated from your house – kitchen, bathroom, and laundry.

You can get a rebate of up to \$500 on your regular septic maintenance.

King County is offering a rebate of up to \$500 per property for regular septic system inspection, pumping, or riser installation for properties in King County with a septic system.

Save money and keep local water clean!

Being a good steward of your septic system means that you are doing your part to improve the health of local water and all that live here.

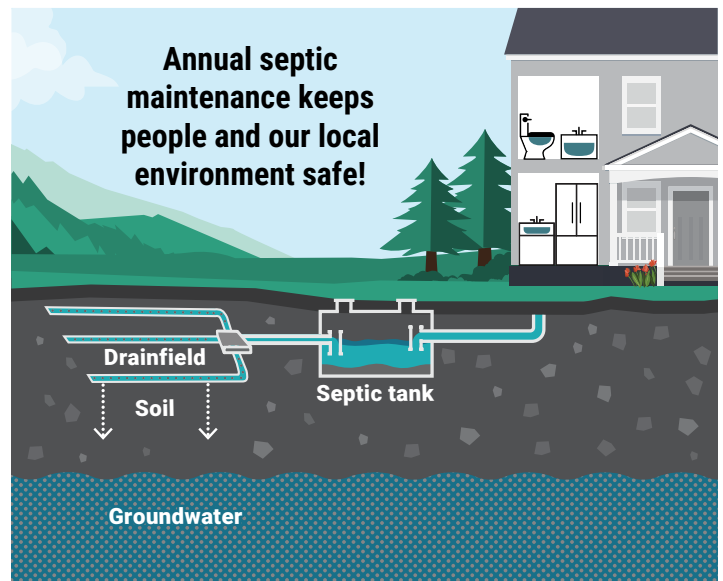
Why maintenance is important:

- **Saves you money.**
Spend some money now for routine maintenance and avoid the larger cost of repairing or replacing a failing septic system.
- **Keeps your community healthy.**
Help remove harmful bacteria and viruses in well water and local lakes, rivers, and creeks.
- **Protects your property value.**
An unusable septic system lowers your property value and poses a potentially costly legal liability. Disclosing a septic system failure is a seller's duty (chapter 64.06RCW).
