Seattle King County REALTORS® First Citizen Scholarship Awards are presented in honor of the many contributions made by REALTORS® and their families to the growth, health and betterment of our communities, as exemplified by the recipients of the Seattle First Citizen Award.

Awards shall be for a maximum of \$5,000 per year, per recipient. The number and amount of the awards shall be determined annually by the SFCSF Board of Directors, based upon the contributions received in any given year. SFCSF is a 501c(3) charitable corporation, so your contributions are tax deductible.

The SFCSF Board of Directors will review all applications and select the winners who will be invited to attend the 81st Annual First Citizen Awards Banquet.

REQUIREMENTS

Applications may be obtained through SKCR. All applications and supporting documents must be received by April 1, 2019.

1. The applicant or his or her parent(s) or grandparent(s), aunt or uncle, must be a member-in-good-standing i.e. dues paid in full, (REALTOR® or Affiliate) of the Seattle King County REALTORS® for a minimum of one year, as of April 1, 2019.
2. The applicant must be a high school senior or graduate and meet admission requirements of the school or educational program selected that leads to a degree, certification, or professionally recognized program for self-improvement. For SKCR member applicants, program must be real estate related.
3. The applicant must manifest qualities of character, good citizenship, leadership, intellectual capacity and self-reliance and exhibit exemplary standards of personal conduct.
4. The applicant must fill out an application form and submit it with three letters of recommendation and copies of their transcripts (if applicable). Applicants may be required to submit to a personal interview.
5. A one-page typed resume should be included, highlighting the applicant's academic, leadership, volunteer and community service activities. The applicant must also include a typed, one-page essay on the following topic: "Describe your involvement with volunteer and/or community service activities and how you plan to use the scholarship. Describe how you personally have contributed to the betterment of our community."
